## CHAPTER KY-C PROFILE

“BlueGrass Wings” was one of 3 Kentucky chapters that were simultaneously chartered in 1982 (Chapter Ky-A Louisville - Chapter Ky-B Paducah) by GWRRA headquarters in Phoenix. The “BlueGrass Wings” has always called Lexington its home with the majority of its membership residing in Fayette and surrounding counties. It is currently one of 16 active chapters within our state (District). All Kentucky chapters belong to Region “N” (Appalachian Region) which also includes chapters located in the states of North Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia and Tennessee.

Chapter “C” meets on the fourth Tuesday of each month at GattiTown located on Nicholasville Road (next to K-Mart and Red Lobster) in Lexington. Fellowship and meal starts at 6:00 PM and the formal meeting begins at 7:15 PM. The Chapter has scheduled rides monthly which depart from a marshalling area located behind the Chevron station on North Broadway (Paris Pike US 27/68) and the I-75 \ I-64 interchange (Exit 113).
